Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

The PEC Survey team created a list of FAQs for survey vendors here: https://pcfpecs.org/ General-Information/FAQs d. These FAQs include survey vendor requirements, survey and data collection details, PECS contact information, and other relevant material. For example:

Which official CAHPS survey needs to be fielded for PCF?

The PCF PECS is based on a combination of questions from the CG-CAHPS v. 3.0 and CAHPS Patient-Centered Medical Home Item Set v. 3.0. A copy of the survey will be posted on the PCF PECS web portal for vendors and practice sites in Spring 2021. More details regarding sample size, data submission, and other vendor specific information will become available when the vendor solicitation period opens. The vendor solicitation period will begin in conjunction with the start of PCF in January 2021.

Upcoming 2021 Deadlines & Reminders

1/4 — Invited survey vendors can apply to become a PCF PEC Survey vendor

2/1 — Survey vendor application is due

2/15 — Conditional approval notice will be sent to survey vendors, including a link to sign up for the required training session

3/24-3/25 — Survey vendor training

4/16 — Quality Assurance Plans (QAPs) are due

5/24 — Full approval notice will be sent to survey vendors who have completed vendor training & QAP

6/30 —Deadline for practice sites to authorize or change a survey vendor

9/28 — Survey data collection begins

12/21 — Survey data collection ends
